Product data sheet

General description 1.

The 74LV4053 is a triple single-pole double-throw (SPDT) analog switch, suitable for use as an analog or digital multiplexer/demultiplexer. It is a low-voltage Si-gate CMOS device and is pin and function compatible with the 74HC4053 and 74HCT4053. Each switch has a digital select input (Sn), two independent inputs/outputs (nY0 and nY1) and a common input/output (nZ). All three switches share an enable input (E). A HIGH on E causes all switches into the high-impedance OFF-state, independent of Sn.

 V_{CC} and GND are the supply voltage connections for the digital control inputs (Sn and \overline{E}). The V_{CC} to GND range is 1 V to 6 V. The analog inputs/outputs (nY0, nY1 and nZ) can swing between V_{CC} as a positive limit and V_{EE} as a negative limit. $V_{CC} - V_{EE}$ may not exceed 6 V. For operation as a digital multiplexer/demultiplexer, VEE is connected to GND (typically ground). V_{EE} and V_{SS} are the supply voltage connections for the switches.







Triple single-pole double-throw analog switch



^[1] To avoid drawing V_{CC} current out of terminal nZ, when switch current flows into terminals nYn, the voltage drop across the bidirectional switch must not exceed 0.4 V. If the switch current flows into terminal nZ, no V_{CC} current will flow out of terminals nYn, and in this case there is no limit for the voltage drop across the switch, but the voltages at nYn and nZ may not exceed V_{CC} or V_{EE}.

^[2] The minimum input voltage rating may be exceeded if the input current rating is observed.





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




Fig 13. Enable and disable times





Fig 15. Test circuit for measuring frequency response

Fig 16. Typical frequency response





Fig 17. Test circuit for measuring isolation (OFF-state)






Fig 19. Test circuit for measuring total harmonic distortion




a. Test circuit




b. Input and output pulse definitions V_I may be connected to Sn or \overline{E} .

b. Switch open condition

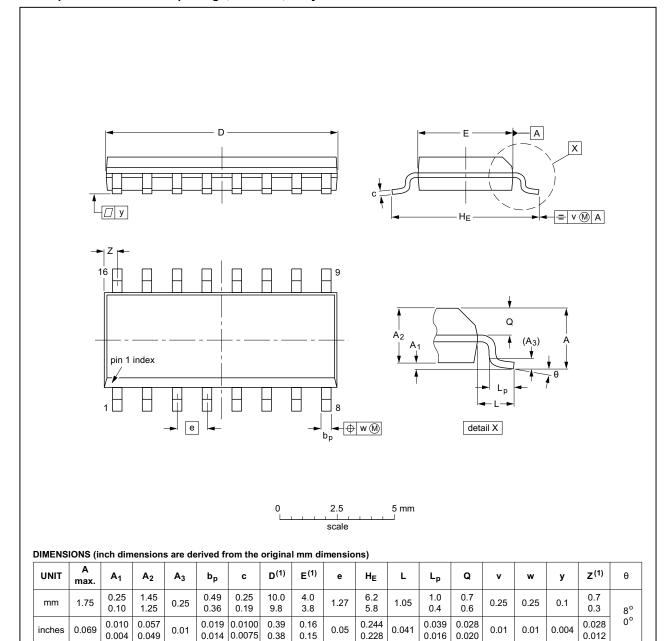
Fig 21. Test circuit for measuring crosstalk between switches

Fig 22. Package outline SOT109-1 (SO16)

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


Fig 23. Package outline SOT338-1 (SSOP16)




Fig 25. Package outline SOT763-1 (DHVQFN16)
