


Figure 1. Typical Instantaneous Forward Characteristics

Figure 2. Maximum Instantaneous Forward Characteristics




Figure 3. Typical Reverse Characteristics

Figure 4. Maximum Reverse Characteristics




Figure 5. Typical Junction Capacitance





Figure 6. Current Derating

Figure 7. Forward Power Dissipation






Figure 8. Thermal Characteristics






